School District Question 1 School Building Bonds High School Renovations; Elementary Security

Shall the board of Independent School District No. 682 (Roseau Public Schools), Minnesota be authorized to issue general obligation school building bonds in an amount not to exceed \$36,990,000 for acquisition and betterment of school sites and facilities, including but not limited to, High School additions and renovations and Elementary Secured entry improvements?
